

CHAPTER 14
THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE

107. The chief executive of THETA shall be appointed by the Executive Committee on such terms of service as may be determined by the Executive Committee.
108. The chief executive shall be responsible to and shall report to the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall give the chief executive such direction and supervision as may be necessary to enable him or her to perform the function of the position in a fit and proper manner.
109. The powers, functions, rights, duties and delegated powers of the chief executive shall be as determined from time to time by THETA. The chief executive shall be responsible and accountable for the recruitment, appointment and management of all employees of THETA.
110. The chief executive, in consultation with the Executive Committee, shall appoint not more than 3 deputy chief executive officers and such other staff as may be necessary and may determine the duties and fix the remuneration of such staff.
